- 10. What are your personal strengths?
- 11. Tell me about a time when you had to deal with a conflict.
- 12. Explain how your previous work experience qualifies you for participation in the MYEP.
- 13. How would you handle an angry client or customer?
- 14. What are your weaknesses?
- 15. Please describe your work ethic.

## The following questions received one vote each:

- 8. Give me an example of a situation that best demonstrates your ability to work well with a team of people.
- 9. You are given several important assignments that need to be completed as soon as possible. How do you establish priorities?
- 10. Describe your organizational abilities.
- 11. How quickly can you learn a new process or software?
- 12. How do you define success and failure?
